MINUTES OF NORTH CADBURY AND YARLINGTON PC PLANNING MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 13TH MARCH 2018 AT 2.55PM TO CONSIDER PA 18/00332/LBC – RE-PAINTING OF EXTERNAL WALLS AND REPLACEMENT OF TWO FLOODLIGHTS AT NORTH CADBURY VILLAGE HALL

Present: Cllr M Hunt (Chairman), Cllr S Cox, Cllr Handley, Cllr A Keys-Toyer and Cllr M Martin.

In attendance: Mr J Rundle (Agent) and one member of the public.

18/49. Declarations of interest: None.

18/50. The Chairman opened the meeting at 2.55pm: The Applicant explained the application. The PC, being aware that the Conservation Officer had been consulted, noted the unpainted stone area on the Village Hall which is not in a good condition and would benefit greatly from painting, following the necessary repair to the rendering. It was also supportive of the whole Hall being repainted. The proposed colour of Dulux County Cream, which appears to be that, or something very close to it, of many of the surrounding dwellings and in the village generally, was supported. The PC recognised that the two Car Park lights and sensors were no longer fit for purpose and supported the updating of the current system with 30w LED lighting and improved sensors.

18/51. Resolution: The Parish Council resolved unanimously to **APPROVE** the **Application**.
