

HIGHWAYS REPORT OCTOBER 2024

POTHOLES

1. Sandbrook Lane - opposite Greenlands small pothole developed ,located amongst multiple previous repairs .
2. Parish Hill - outside Montgomery road entrance appears to be permanent flooding !
3. Slip road to A303 near Teals - road surface now badly rutted (strictly not our area but should be addressed urgently)
4. Manor Farm Woolston Road - now 2 potholes in road outside entrance .
5. Woolston Manor Farm - several potholes just past the entrance .
6. Woolston Road continue - just before Lower Clapton Farm the bridge is badly flooding (again this may be outside our area)
7. Yarlington Lodge Hill - outside Hilltop, previous repairs breaking up with potholes .
8. Lodge Hill - half way down the hill a large rectangular repair has broken up at 1 end. Bottom of Lodge Hill at the junction ,pothole developed.
9. West Street - as leaving Yarlington pothole on right hand side .
10. Stoke Lane - large hole in front of site of new houses. Another hole has developed a bit further along .
11. Galhampton Long Street - outside Orchards large pothole. Road surface also breaking up around manhole cover .
12. Frog Lane - as previously reported road edges breaking up .
13. Back Lane - road breaking up in numerous places .

OTHER ISSUES

Mitchells Row N.C. - Drain outside Brookhampton cottage blocked so water bubbling out onto road and draining towards Cary Rd.

Main A359 - vicinity of Orchard Inn - a drain cover is banging as traffic runs over it (report from residents) .

At this time of the year there is a lot of drain cover blockage with leaves . If the general public can just scrape this away if they see it then the drainage will improve and lessen the subsequent damage to the roads .
